
## Tertiär T.

T. stands for the variety Roter Traminer.

The vineyard is located in Mordthal. This is one of the highest lying single sides of the Wagram.

As the name of the wine reveals, the soil contains a very high amount of gravel - Tertiär gravel -

Harvest - 01 October

Alkohol - 13.00

residual sugar - 1.8

acidity - 5.6

Bottles - 2101 Flaschen

The grapes were harvested and destemmed by hand on October 1st. Fermentation took place with the entire mash. The mash was punched down daily, and after 14 days, the grapes were pressed to completely extract the fermented juice from the berries. The wine was then racked into two 500-liter barrels made of local acacia wood. Over a period of two months, the lees were stirred several times, thus highlighting the delicate flavor profile of the Roter Traminer.
