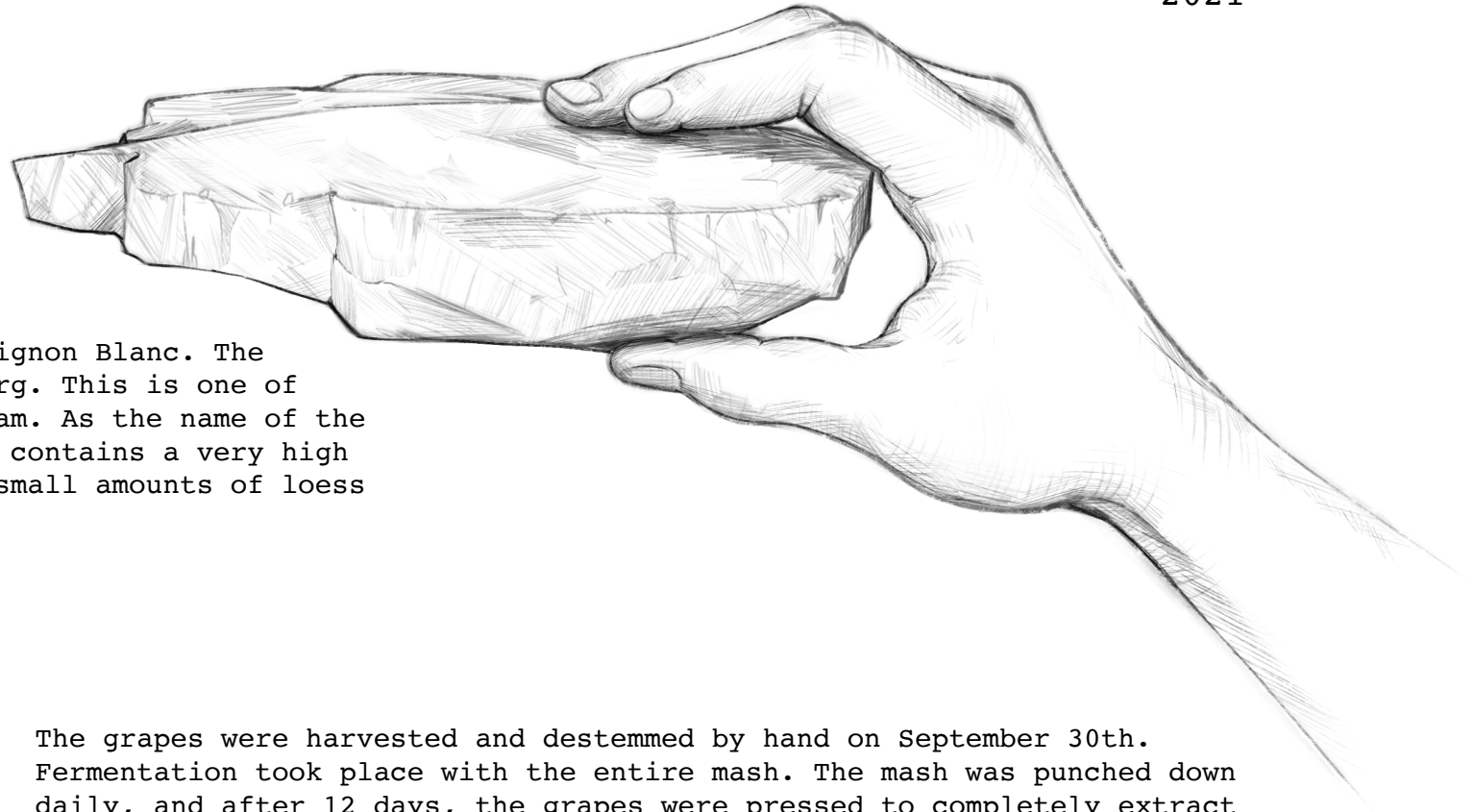


## Tertiär S.

S. stands for the variety Sauvignon Blanc. The vineyard is located in Steinberg. This is one of the best locations of the Wagram. As the name of the wine already reveals, the soil contains a very high gravel content in addition to small amounts of loess - Tertiär gravel -

Harvest - 30 September

Alcohol - 12.00

residual sugar - 1.2

acidity - 7.90

Bottles - 2095

The grapes were harvested and destemmed by hand on September 30th. Fermentation took place with the entire mash. The mash was punched down daily, and after 12 days, the grapes were pressed to completely extract the fermented juice from the berries. The wine was then transferred to a 500-liter barrel made of local acacia wood. To promote the aromatic tension of the Sauvignon Blanc, the lees were stirred every other day for the first month.
