Ried Steinberg is one of the largest, but also one of the best locations in Wagram.

Josef Fritz: "For me, it's the ideal location for Roter Veltliner: dry and hot, just what this indigenous variety needs. Nowhere else does it thrive as well and as healthily as here."

The name comes from the stony sandy soil, which alternates with loess here. At the foot of the mountain, loess dominates and merges further up into sandy loess over a stony subsoil. Tertiary gravel dominates at the top, almost 370 meters above sea level. Steinberg is one of the very highest sites in Wagram.
